








ABOUT THE CRICHTON



The Crichton comprises 85 acres of parkland and 27 historic sandstone buildings, located on the outskirts of Dumfries in the South of Scotland.

The Crichton has a business park with 100+ public, private and third sector organisations, including South of Scotland Enterprise (SOSE), The Scotland 5G Centre, a refurbished 71-bedroom hotel and a multi-institution academic campus. The Crichton Golf Club and Midpark Hospital are also adjacent to the estate.

The Crichton benefits from vast open spaces, beautifully landscaped grounds, a rock garden and a rose garden, which are all maintained by The Crichton Trust. The Crichton is one of the largest entertainment venues in the South of Scotland, with various indoor and outdoor event spaces and venues including; Easterbrook Hall, Easterbrook Bistro, Bar and Spa, Crichton Central and the Crichton Memorial Church and lawns.

The Crichton was created with a purpose of protecting, nurturing and caring for people and their physical and mental health and wellbeing and we are encouraged by the continued demand for our indoor and outdoor spaces and venues for corporate, educational, leisure and social events, exhibitions, festivals and celebrations.










EASTERBROOK HALL FLOORPLAN







The Crichton Memorial Church is a wellknown and much-loved landmark at The Crichton. In 1890, work on the cathedralstyle sandstone church, designed by Edinburgh based architect Sydney Mitchell, commenced and was built as a fitting memorial for James and Elizabeth Crichton. It boasts an impressive oak roof, stone carvings by William Vickers of Glasgow, stunning Irish and Sicilian marble floors, stained windows by Oscar Paterson and a rare and much-admired Lewis Organ.

A dedication service was held on 15 October 1897 and since then has continued to be a regular place of worship and a unique venue for celebrations and events including; wedding ceremonies, wine and dine events, graduations, funerals, choirs, concerts and tours and has also been used for ty broadcasts and as a film location too.










Easterbrook BAR & SPA BISTR



Easterbrook Bistro, Bar and Spa is a modern bistro-style café and bar set within the stunning grounds of The Crichton. Although accessed via its own private entrance, Easterbrook Bistro is part of Easterbrook Hall and is also home to the on-site swimming pool and spa and a privately run beauty salon. Open 7 days a week, Easterbrook Bistro is a popular stop for coffee, cake, lunches and afternoon

teas and is also perfectly located for preevent drinks, private receptions, group gatherings and spa days. Service times are seasonal. Pool memberships and passes also available.

CRICHTON CENTRAL



Crichton Central is a high-tech co-working space with a busy café and a suite of rooms including a FlexiSpace and four meeting rooms. The co-working space is dedicated to members and pass holders, while the other meeting rooms and spaces are readily available for private hire. The café has a deli counter, bar, public lounge, outdoor terrace and serviced lawn and also offers takeaways and catering for meeting rooms and events. By day, the lounge is popular with site users and local residents for breakfasts, lunches and coffees, but can be transformed into an events space for early morning business breakfasts,


evening art classes, live concerts, public lectures, product launches and networking events. Crichton Central is also home to The Scotland 5G Centre's Dumfries Hub and Testbed and a Community Radio Station and is equipped with the latest sound, lighting and streaming equipment making it suitable for live, streamed and hybrid events. 

OUTDOOR VENUES




When it comes to outdoor spaces, The Crichton has the flexibility to host a range of outdoor events and the facilities and expertise to provide hospitality and event management support too. This year alone, The Crichton has hosted the Doonhame Festival, The Royal Burgh of Dumfries Tattoo, Illyria Outdoor Theatre Shows, Year of Stories Tours and Learning Picnic, Drive in Movies, storytelling events, memorial events at the Tree of Tranquillity and the National British Road Championship Time Trials. The weekly Crichton Parkrun also takes place on site every Saturday morning. The Crichton has also been

known to host sports days, community picnics, fun days, corporate away days, outdoor weddings and BBQs. Outdoor events can take place on the main lawn next to the Crichton Memorial Church, on the playing fields next to the pavilion, in the main carpark at Easterbrook Hall, on the lawn at Crichton Central and in the gardens. For larger events, the estate can be transformed into a sporting arena, showground and festival site.



ABOUT THE CRICHTON TRUST



The Crichton Trust is a company limited by guarantee with charitable status, established in 1996 to promote, regenerate and care for The Crichton and other buildings of historic interest throughout Dumfries and Galloway. Part of the Trust's overall strategic responsibility is to develop The Crichton with a clear identity as a place of educational, commercial, recreational, cultural and artistic excellence.

We connect people, place and the past to shape the future and we want to inspire people to live, work and study well at The Crichton. As a social enterprise we value the legacy of The Crichton and we understand our responsibility to protect our people and our place, so we are ambitious in our endeavours to create an exciting, lively and sustainable future for our community.

We have a refreshed appreciation for what is important; social connections, outdoor spaces, respect and kindness, partnerships, education, health and wellbeing, adaptability, innovation, sustainability and resilience, all of which are core qualities of The Crichton.

HISTORY AND HERITAGE



The story of The Crichton begins in 1823, with the death of Dr James Crichton of Friars Carse. Dr Crichton left his widow, Elizabeth Crichton, £100,000 to use for charitable purposes.

This resulted in The Crichton; a stunning 85-acre parkland estate on the outskirts of Dumfries in the South of Scotland. Elizabeth's original ambition was to create a university in Dumfries for the education of 'poor scholars'. Despite a 20-year battle to make it a reality, a university was not to be in her time. Instead she created a psychiatric hospital with a world-wide reputation – it was the best in Europe, not only in its treatment of patients, but also in its architecture and environment. The doors opened in 1839 and for the next 150 years it grew to become an internationally recognised centre of excellence in mental health research and care.

In the 1980's the care and treatment of patients with mental health changed and demand for the hospital diminished. In 1995, the local authority took the decision, with courage and foresight, to purchase the estate from the Health Board. It did so with the primary objective of ensuring the public asset was saved, protected and sensitively developed for the good of the wider community. It was also recognised, that there was, at last, the chance to respond to local ambitions to develop a much-needed University Campus offering local access to Higher Education and fulfilling Elizabeth Crichton's dream of having a university in Dumfries.

Although the local authority continue to own the estate they now lease it on a long-term basis (125 years) unencumbered to The Crichton Trust which is a wholly independent charitable company.
